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Job Description – QA/QC Engineer

The QA/QC Engineer is responsible for maintaining the quality system and monitoring shop floor operations in a *mechanical manufacturing environment*. It is a hands-on job. Additional duties are safety training, supplies purchasing, Hazmat, regulatory filings and recordkeeping. You will assist the Production Manager in his absence. This position is a direct report to the President. The workday is varied and busy, your ability to multitask is key. You must be organized, have excellent communication, problem solving and critical thinking skills.

Duties and Responsibilities

- Perform some incoming, in-process, and final inspections.
- Specify and implement corrective action plans as required.
- Maintain the quality procedures/manual and write new procedures when necessary.
- Assist sales people with product specifications and some customer communications.
- Communicate with suppliers to resolve quality issues.
- Maintain inventory of shop supplies and tools, place orders when necessary.
- Assist with biannual inventory and cycle counts as required.

Skills and Specifications

You must

- have at least three years' experience in QA/QC. Leadership roles and ASQ certifications are a plus.
- be a focused, organized person. Operate among a seasoned workforce.
- have a solid work ethic, attention to detail, and a professional demeanor. Work independently.
- be able to write and convey technical information for production, suppliers and customers.
- be proficient in Microsoft Office, specifically Microsoft Word and Excel. Access a plus.
- be willing to get your hands dirty. Uniforms will be supplied if desired.
- be capable of working in demanding situations when required.

Education and Qualifications

To apply for this job, you should have manufacturing experience in a mechanical environment. An engineering degree is not required but would be most helpful. Light math skills are necessary. Computer experience is required, and technical knowledge of PCs is an advantage.
